Special care was taken in selecting questions. Items originated from established surveys used throughout the United States—some for more than 25 years. OHYES! questions cover:

- ✓ Demographics
- ✓ Alcohol & Tobacco/Vapor Products
- ✓ Marijuana & Other Drugs
- ✓ Bullying, Safety & School Climate
- ✓ Physical Health & Well-being
- ✓ Mental Health & Gambling
- ✓ Parental Attitudes of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use
- ✓ Community, Family & Peer Factors
- ✓ School Success

What is OHYES!

- It's the **Ohio Healthy Youth Environments Survey**
- An online health survey
- Free. Voluntary. Anonymous.
- All Ohio schools with students in grades 7-12 are eligible to participate
- 2 versions (available on our website)
- Takes about 15 minutes
- Administered October – November 2015 & every 4 years
- Communities can elect to do it annually

How Can OHYES! Results Be Used?

- **Data:** To provide a snapshot of youth health behaviors in each county across the state of Ohio and to better understand interrelated issues and address youth needs
- **Planning:** For needs assessment, strategic planning, and to help schools determine priorities
- **Policy and Programming:** To guide policy, to prioritize program strategies, to track progress program goals, and to meet state and federal program requirements
- **Funding:** To provide rationale for federal, state, local, and foundation grants
- **Advocacy:** To raise awareness of youth needs, to foster stronger school-parent-community relationships, and to promote healthy life choices
